Maher (Mother's Home in Marathi) was founded by Sr Lucy Kurien in 1997 to provide care and shelter to destitute women, children and men, and to undertake various community development projects. The first Maher home was established in 1997 in Vadu Budruk near Pune. Since then, Maher has expanded its activities to various locations in Maharashtra, Kerala, Jharkhand, West Bengal, Karnataka, Bihar and Andhra Pradesh. Today Maher operates 66 homes across 7 states that provide an inclusive, loving, supportive home to 996 children, 172 men and 595 destitute women. In addition, our Teams work on 25 different outreach projects including 624 village self-help groups (SHGs). Over the years, Maher has provided shelter to over 50,000 women, men and children and impacted thousands through the various trainings and support offered to the self-help groups (SHGs).

Maher's contributions to social development have been recognized by numerous national and international organizations. The United Nations granted us special consultative status with the United Nations Economic and Social Council, May 2017. Maher was also listed among the 'Top 10 NGOs' by the India NGO Awards.

I am happy to present to you the Annual Report of Maher for the year 2023-24. Relieved that we have finally left the dark days of the Covid-19 pandemic behind, we have once again started pursuing our noble cause in full swing and with utmost enthusiasm.

During the year, as detailed in this Report, Maher has been doing extremely fruitful work, following its main mission of uplifting underprivileged women from their abysmal state of poverty. Maher was started 27 years ago with this very goal in mind, and despite its varied projects over the years, it is still committed to it. To fulfil one of Maher's main objectives, which is to help women become economically self-reliant, empowering them to lead a life of dignity and respect, we are striving to develop income-earning skills among them through a broad net of self-help groups, which today total to over 600 under the auspices of Maher.

A bhoomi puja of the land at Raxaul in Bihar and the inauguration of a home at Loni in Karnataka this year show that Maher has been growing steadily and reaching even more sections of underprivileged groups in our country. This has been possible only through the generosity of people and divine energy, for which I am ever grateful. The contribution of my colleagues and the staff is no less

valuable and I am extremely thankful for all that they have done for Maher.

My name has appeared once again in the 30th position in Ooom's List of World Celebrities. I take this as a great honour for the whole of Maher and all those connected with Maher's work, and I express, on behalf of them, feelings of gratitude to the editors of the scroll of honour.

With these words, I humbly present to you this Report of our work over the last year.



Executive Summary

Eye Health Check-up Camp (2nd Apr 2023)

Infigo Hospital, Ratnagiri, organized an eye check-up camp for all Maher Ratnagiri residents. Doctors were available to check the eye health of senior citizens and children. All Maher staff were present, and many camps were organized in different centres in all seven states.



Maher girl becomes a keyboardist (Apr 2023)

It was an immense pleasure to see a Maher girl, Nikita Pimenta, become a keyboardist. Sr. Lucy received an invitation to attend the program as a chief guest. Maher nurtures values of love, compassion, kindness, and gratefulness in its children, and we always hope that the same is reciprocated in their life, wherever their journey leads them. Maher is always proud to be a part of their life journey.



A 7-day youth camp at Ahmedabad proves to be a highly rewarding experience for Maher youth (9th to 17th May 2023)

It was a beautiful experience for 36 Maher youth, who travelled to Ahmedabad from the Maher Pune Centre at Vadhu BK, and got the opportunity to explore a new dimension of their life journey. Every day our youth met new people during the camp, and everyone made them feel special. The closing ceremony on 17th May, saw happiness, contentment, new hope and positive energy in the eyes of every Maher youth present.

'Prabhat pheri', which literally means early morning rounds, is a tradition or a ritual lost in the facade of modernization. A long time ago, people from the villages would get up early in the morning much before sunrise, and walk around the village chanting and singing 'bhajans' and playing ethnic instruments. It is believed that this ritual invoked the good spirits, and would chase away the evil spirits of the night, further welcoming the morning with good vibrations. Our youth participated in daily prabhat pheri during the camp. Sr. Lucy strongly believes in inculcating traditional values in our children and tried to do the same during the youth camp.



Annual Trip (15th May 2023)



This year's annual trip for the staff and children was organised at the Bhatye beach, Ratnagiri. Nearly 40 children and staff visited the fort, Thibaw Point, and Jija Mata Garden. After spending time at the beach, the children enjoyed a delicious meal at Surabhi Hotel and then returned home.

Sports Camp (24th To 26th May 2023)

The children at Maher's Jharkhand home have hailed from rural and under privileged backgrounds. Maher ensures them a good education as well as an opportunity to develop their talents through participation in its sport camps.



The objective is to showcase their hidden talents by encouraging them to perform on stage to increase their confidence level.

The children participated with full zest in the sports camp. Mr. Amol T, Mr. Mangesh P, Mr. Prashant G, Mr. Vinayak G, Sr. Shaicy, Shobha and all the Jharkhand team worked hard to organize the event and make it successful.

Health Check-up Camp (27th May 2023)

Rural hospital and Hind Lab organized health check-ups for all men, women, and children at the Maher Ratnagiri centre. The check-up included tests for monitoring of blood pressure, blood sugar, dental health, mental health, skin care, height and weight. Medical experts were available to advise on senior citizens' and children's health, and to prescribe medications as needed.



House Mothers Training (6-9 Jun 2023)

We organized a transformative and empowering four-day training for over 75 House Mothers at Maher. From 6th to 9th June, we delved into a holistic program, covering various essential topics that equip these women with invaluable knowledge and skills.

Our training began with sessions on mindful meditation, allowing our House Mothers to find inner peace, reduce stress, and cultivate self-care practices. It was truly a time of tranquillity and self-reflection.

We then shifted our focus to the critical topic of fire safety, ensuring that our House Mothers are well-prepared to handle any emergency. We believe in keeping everyone safe, and this training emphasized the importance of proactive measures and quick responses.

While addressing another crucial issue in today's society, we conducted education sessions on preventing and addressing sexual abuse. We focus on empowering our House Mothers with the knowledge and tools to protect themselves and the children in their care.

To wrap up this enriching experience, we organized a delightful outing for our House Mothers on the final day, which was followed with a sumptuous lunch. It was a perfect opportunity for bonding, relaxation, and rejuvenation, fostering a sense of community and support among these women.

We extend our heartfelt gratitude to all the participants, facilitators, and everyone who contributed to the success of this meeting of our House Mothers. Maher Parliament (16th Jun 2023)

All Maher Children came back to their respective centres after the summer vacation and the staff welcomed them as per Maher tradition.



Every year Maher organizes a Parliament where children get the opportunity to learn various aspects of leadership concerning leading the nation and also leading their own personal and professional lives. This year's Maher Parliament proceedings started with the elections. Each centre elected six

'ministers' and they were felicitated in a small ceremony.

Computer Lab Inaugurated (3rd July 2023)

The inauguration of the computer lab in Bakori was done at the hands of Sr. Lucy and Mr. Sunil Kamble. On the occasion, Sr. Lucy addressed the children on the importance of computer education in their career. The inauguration coincided with the 16th anniversary of the Bakori Project and celebration of Guru Poornima, observed as Teacher's Day. The children performed symbolic washing of the feet of Sister and Mr Kamble and gave them a letter of greetings.



Trip to Tirupati Balaji organised (17th July 2023)

A major trip was planned for 30 children and 3 staff by Paramsing Gandhi & team to the Tirupati Balaji temple, which is called the Bhuloka Vaikuntam – the abode of Vishnu on earth: it is believed that Lord Vishnu manifested Himself in this temple during the Kali age to guide and direct His devotees towards salvation.

The trip began with children gathering at the Swagat House where they were briefed about the formalities of the trip. The participants

boarded the train on the afternoon of 17th July and reached Tirupati the next morning. After breakfast, the children went to the famous Balaji temple by bus. It was refreshing to see the continuously lit lamps in the temple where children held a short prayer.

On the 20th July, the children travelled to the Padmavati Paduka temple dedicated to the Goddess Laxmi. They offered prayers in the temple and left for Pune. The children thoroughly enjoyed the trip, and found it very refreshing and inspiring.



Eye Examination Camp (5th August 2023)



An eye check-up camp was organized by Maher in association with KK Hospital in which over 150 Maher boys and girls were examined. The children were also given information about eye care during the camp. In Pune as well all the Maher centres held an eyecheck-

up for their children in association with Drushti Foundation.

Birsa Munda Jayanti observed (6th August 2023)

Birsa Munda was a tribal freedom fighter, religious leader, and folk hero who belonged to the Munda tribe. He spearheaded an Indian tribal mass movement that arose in the tribal belt of modern Odisha, Bihar, Jharkhand, Madhya Pradesh, and Chattisgarh in the late 19th century during the British Raj. On the occasion of his birth anniversary, Maher organized Adivasi (Tribal) Day at Thakarvasti which was well attended by the members of the tribal community.



On the occasion, the organizers spoke about Birsa Munda's work and how his thoughts were still relevant to the development of the tribal population. The present schemes for the welfare of the tribal community were also discussed.



World Tribal Day (9th August 2023)

On the occasion of Tribal Day, Maherites conducted a special service and prayed for the well-being of the tribal people. They also prayed for favourable weather and good harvest. This was followed by entertaining cultural programs by Maher children. A vote of thanks was given by Mr. Kishore.



For peace on Mother Earth (11th August 2023)

Maher youth were happy to be a part of the Harmony Peace Pilgrimage organized by Maher's well-wisher and friend, Vishwamitra Yogesh. It was a unique harmony initiative across various religious beliefs in the camp area of Pune city, where Maher children held prayers in 8 different places of worship.

Blood donation camp organised on Sister's birthday (10th September 2023)

For Sr. Lucy, a birthday is a day to give something back to society. Whenever people ask what she likes for her birthday, she always says

that she would like to join hands with people for donating blood to the poorest of the poor. She did so on her birthday this year too when Maher's staff organized a blood donation camp and many people including villagers visited Maher and donated blood.



Journey with Young Women Entrepreneurs (11th September 2023)

Sr. Lucy Kurien was invited to share her life journey with young women entrepreneurs by Dr. Sonam Kapase, the founder of Terrassine Food Corp. It was an opportunity for Sister Lucy to exchange thoughts with young women entrepreneurs, and Maher is thankful to Ms Kapase for the arrangement of this event.

Reunited with family after years (19th September 2023)

Ramilaben Patel who was found on Chennai National Highway was brought to the Maher Tirupati centre. In due course, the Maher staff succeeded in retrieving her background information from her. Based on that information, the staff identified her village as Dakor in Gujarat and duly contacted the police there. The Dakor police immediately responded to the Maher inquiry and in an hour, located her home in Dakor. On the same night, her husband sent her son to Tirupati to pick her up from the Maher center. It was very emotional for the Maher staff to witness Ramilaben's reunion with her son.



Maher expresses its gratitude to Dakor Police Station who promptly acted in the matter even when there had been no complaint lodged with them by Ramilabehn's family. They went beyond their duty and helped the Maher staff to

search for the family. A pleasant experience indeed!

Goa Picnic (23th September 2023)

Maheer is always providing new learning opportunities to children, women workers, and House Mothers. A four-day trip to Goa was organized for the children and housemates as well as the staff as a break from the routine work. Everyone enjoyed the trip and learned many new things as well. This brought joy and enthusiasm to everyone on the trip.



Gandhi Jayanti (2nd October 2023)

Both Mahatma Gandhi and Lal Bahadur Shastri played a major role in the Indian Independence Movement. Maheer has a high regard for their values of humanity, truth, non-violence, peace, harmony, love, and kindness. To honour these values, Maheer children joined hands in a cleaning drive undertaken jointly by Bajaj Finserv and the Pune Corporation at Agakhan Palace. Children at the Maheer Vadhu Centre visited Sambhaji Maharaj Samadhi and cleaned the area. All of the other centres also chose an area to visit and engaged in cleaning the place. Our camp is packed with exciting activities and valuable lessons

designed to empower our youth. From workshops and skill-building sessions to team challenges and outdoor adventures, there's something for everyone. The excitement among the children is palpable, and we can't wait to embark on this transformative experience together.



Swavalamban Project

Through this project, Maher has been able to reach out and help many needy women. They have been actively dedicated to the work they are doing, which in turn is a help to them and their families. They also actively participated in our 26th Anniversary programs. We continue to organize various programs for their benefit. Hence, we celebrated Women's Day in a big way at Vadhu, Shikrapur, Kendur, Bakori, Satara, Jharkhand, Pune, Ratnagiri, and other places. The women SHGs who had performed well were awarded with a trophy in appreciation of their work.



For the benefit of the people living in Kendur village, Maher organized a health camp wherein tests for TB, cancer, and eye problems were conducted. A total of 677 people were examined and due medication was given. 14 people were operated for their eye problems. Maher sincerely appreciates the work of its staff -Vijay Tawar, Meena Bhagwat, Raju Sakore, Asha Dalvi, and Sushil Pohekar - the tuition class and Balwadi teachers. Vijay Tawar had also visited our project at Jharkhand and gave them valuable guidance, information, and training for the future growth of the Self Help Groups.

The SHG women were given training in skill development that included tailoring, beauty parlour, cooking, and mehendi drawing. Those who completed the course were given certificates.

On the occasion of Mahatma Gandhi Jayanti, women from self-help groups participated in a cleanliness rally at Shikrapur. Awareness programs were conducted on various topics through this self-help group. 50 senior citizens were honoured with gifts on the occasion of Senior Citizen Day at Paath Vasti in Shikrapur. On the occasion of Diwali, 147 women were trained to colour Akash kandils and panatis. Five groups of women went to Alibaug for casual sightseeing and three women from Ramwadi went to see Shaktipeeth. On the occasion of Diwali, a sale-cum-exhibition was organized for women doing business at home. 21 women participated in it and sold goods for three days, and they received a good response. Project Head Vijay Tavar underlined Sister Lucy's vision behind Maher's empowerment programs for women.

Ushalaya Project

The total number of kindergartens under this project has increased to 43. On 19th Sep 2023, a nursery school named Karuna was started at Sanaswadi for the children of citizens who migrated for work. To date, as many as 5,332 children have benefited from the



project. Also, Kindergarten teachers were given a two-day training on innovation in education and teaching in keeping with National Education Policy 2020. Vijay Rao Tavar is responsible for constantly monitoring the progress of the project.

International Environment Day

The day was celebrated at Shikrapur, Pernephata, and Talegaon Dhumdhare. A rally was organized to spread the message of saving water and protecting the



environment. The children organized a skit in Koregaon Bhima wherein they underlined the importance of minimizing the use of plastic in our day-to-day lives.

Tailoring Classes

Maheer has organized tailoring classes in the Satara district as a means to help women become economically self-reliant. Nineteen women have been attending regular training classes in two batches. After completion of the training, an exam will be conducted to evaluate their skills.



World Environment Day

Our Wardha home celebrated this day with local school children by planting trees. Dr. Sachin Pavde, Dr. Prashant Khatdeve, Dr. Praveen Kapse, Adv Kabir Shaikh, and Dharmendra Jawade were guests of honour who appreciated Maheer's efforts to involve the children in the plantation drive. The children performed a skit on saving nature and raising awareness of alcohol addiction.



Summer Camp

Mr. Krishna Banpatte and Mr. Akash Waghmare conducted a summer camp for the children from VMR Nagar, Kallur, and Anepudi villages. These children are recipients of the Maheer nutrition program. Activities such as drawing, singing, and dance competitions were conducted for the children and the winners received their prizes at the end of the day. 150 Children participated in this camp. The staff and parents co-operated well and made the event a joyous one.

Training

Mr. Sagar Wavre organized a training on how to make soybean milk. The participants were trained not only in the technique of making soybean milk, but in the basics of starting their own soybean milk business. Ms. Suprabha Alhat, Mr. Raju Gayan, Ms. Kabita Nayak, and Ms. Sagarika Jana organized the training session.



Participatory Management

The Kerala team regularly takes input from the children to understand their needs and identify opportunities for improvement. The second meeting with the children was held on 29th June. The children also elect their representatives (Chief Minister, Environment Minister, Cultural Minister, Sports Minister, Health Minister, and Education Minister) who work in collaboration with the Maher staff to manage the homes. The new representatives were elected on 4th June. This gives the children an opportunity to gain experience in leadership and organizational skills.

What a joy it was to see Mallika reunited with her family after more than 8 years! Sr. Lucy picked up Mallika from the street and settled her at Maher's Sukhsandhya old age home. A persistent search for her family by Maher workers yielded results. Mallika's two sons and a brother-in-law travelled to Pune from TamilNadu to bring her back home. It was a blessing to see the smiles on their faces on their reunion with Mallika.
